

8th International Congress of the F. M. Alexander Technique

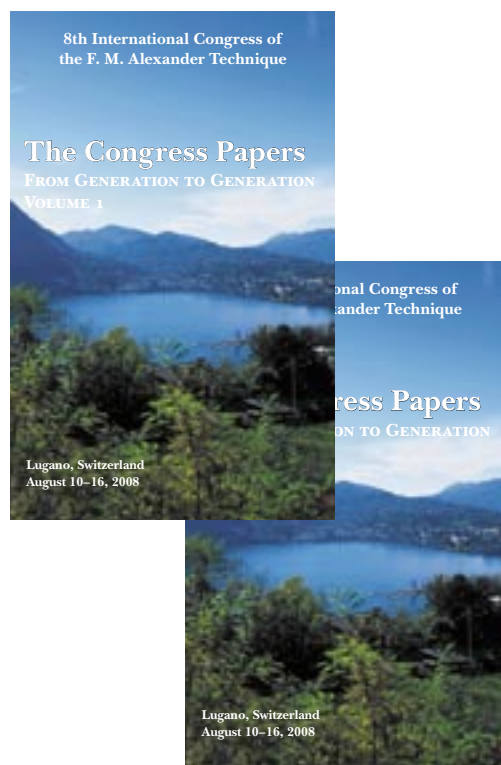
The Congress Papers

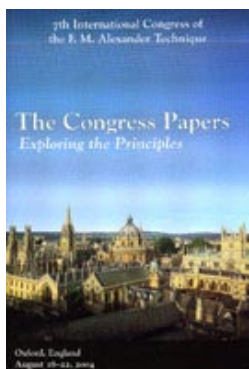
